Tammerfors 12/2-1918.

De röda ha någorlunda försvunnit från gatorna. Kroppsvisitationer förekomma icke mera. Öfverhufvudtaget försiggår allt trögare än i början. Tillfångataganden ha skett vida mera än förut. I allmänhet är stämningen i staden mycket förhoppningsfull och alla äro öfvertygade om de hvitas seger. Någon nervositet försperies senaste söndagen 10/2 på grund af ankomsten af 300-500 matrosar, hvilka slog sig ned i handelsläroverket och hissade upp sin svarta anarkistfana med blodsskallen och de korslagda benen. Själva socialisterna synas frukta för hvad man skall göra med dem, i händelse de begynda med sina grymheter. - Om striderna berättas härvarande tidningar intet. De sårade och fallna hämtas icke hit, hvarför man icke får någon fullkomlig visshet om dem, emedan de röda noggsamt förtiga sakförhållandet och transportera dem till andra orter. I går morse funnos på stationen tre vagnslaster med de rödas lik, men i dag har man redan fört bort dem. Bland de röda finnas många inhjälfrusna. På söndagen 10/2 återvände trupperna från Lyly, men i går begåfvo sig matrosarna och en del röda mot norr. Infanterisoldater ha icke anländt hit, men har i stället från Björneborg ständigt ankommit sådana, hvilka äro på väg mot söder - i slutet af senaste vecka fyra tåg, och denna veckafredan tre tåg, hvarför Björneborgssidan förmodligen redan är någorlunda fri från ryssar. Björneborgsbanan och staden äro i de rödas händer.

I Lavia, Kankaanpää, Ruovesi och i allmänhet dessa trakter ha de röda fått stryk. - Stämningen bland de röda har betydligt nedgått, och hvarje dag ankommer till fabrikerna alltmera manliga arbetare. Löner för strejktiden torde icke ha utbetalts någonstades. Som ett träffande exempel på de rödas osäkerhet i trakten af Lyly må nämnas, att då de hvita på fredagen sprängde banan mellan Lyly och Korkeakoski, körde de röda ystörsta hast alla sina trupper till Korkeakoski, af fruktan för att blifva instängda, då de fingo kännedom om sprängningen. - Förfärande grymt och djuriskt behandla de röda sina fångar, bl. a. ha de i Vanhakartano i Björneborg dödat alla sina fångar, li till antalet. På samma sätt ha de, efter att ha tillfångatagit en kunskapare, utan vidare skjutet honom, då han på de rödas fråga svarade att han "är och alltids kommer att förblifva "slaktare".



The first part of the report is devoted to a general survey of the situation in the country.
