

## **ICE CLASS RULES 1985**

The Finnish Maritime Administration has decided to amend Section 9 of the Ice Class Rules, 1985. The decision enters into force on 1 February 1995.

The Ice Class Rules, 1985 have been published in Circular No 11/2.9.1985 and Annex III to the Rules in Circular No 2/27.1.1986. Amendments made on 25 January 1988 and 17 September 1992 have been published in Circulars No 4/25.1.1988 and 10/26.10.1992 respectively.

## FINNISH MARITIME ADMINISTRATION DECISION ON THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 9 OF THE ICE CLASS RULES, 1985

Helsinki, 31 January 1995

The Finnish Maritime Administration has amended Section 9 of the Ice Class Rules, issued on 2 September 1985 as follows:

Section 9 Ice Class Draught

The Ice Class of a ship shall be based on the ice class that the ship has on a draught which is determined by the official Load Line Mark and the draught which according to the International Tonnage Certificate forms the base for the net tonnage.

This decision shall enter into force on 1 February 1995.
