 Pilot.

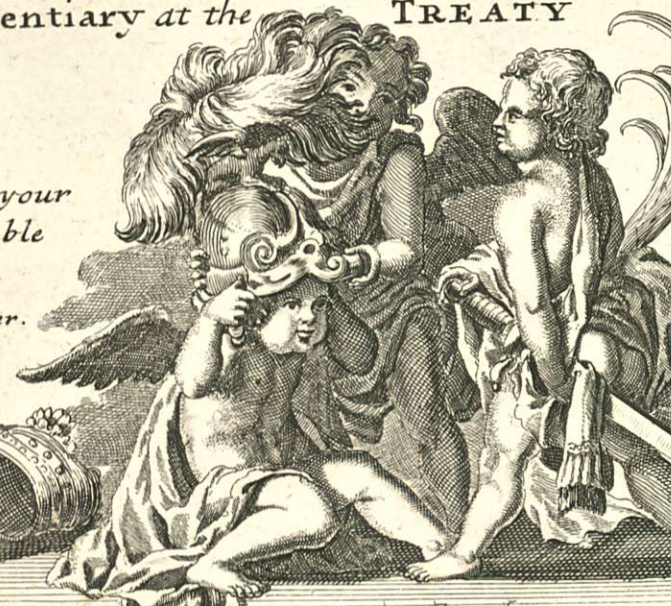
Note that Greenland has no

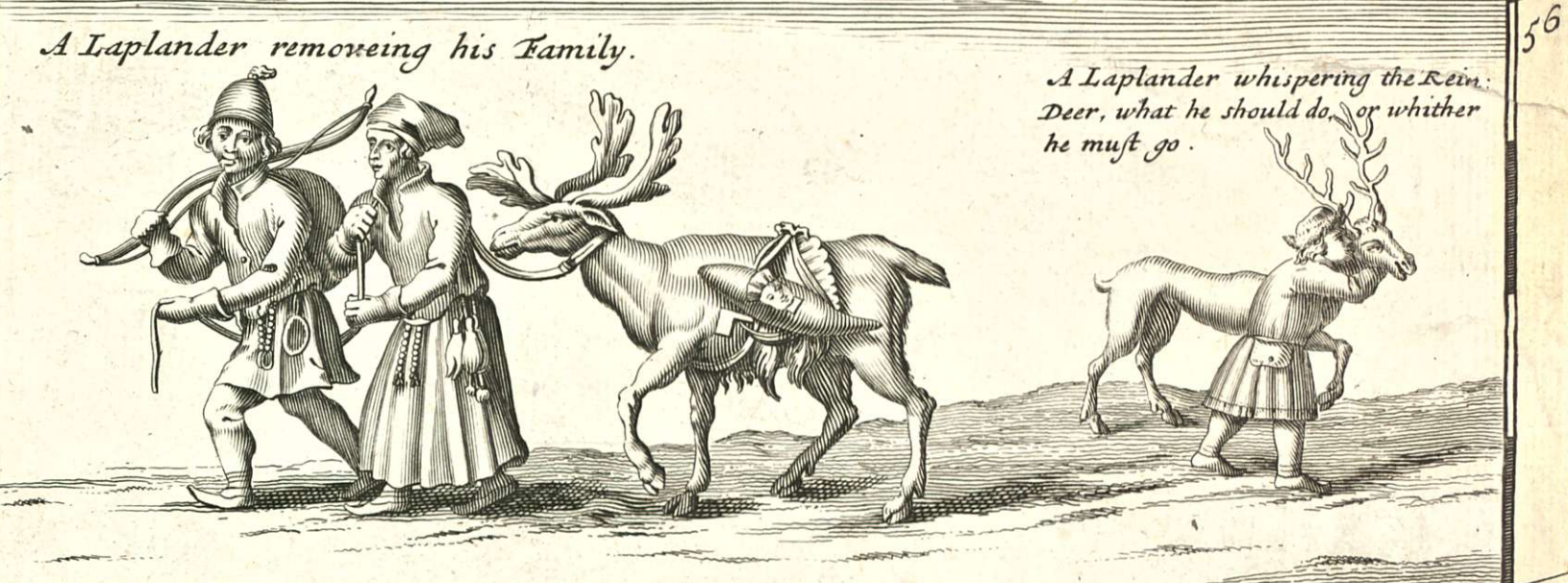
