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### 1. 1970 censuses of population, housing and buildings

The census was taken on 31 December, 1970 and the coding, punching and editing of the collected data were immediately started. The coding of the questionnaires and the punching of some 8 million cards took about 12 months. The first preliminary tables were published in May 1971 (some minor communes) and the tables mentioned in this extract were prepared by the end of June 1972.

In the summer 1972 data on buildings, dwelling units and persons will be combined e.g. to get data on housing conditions of households, combined data on dwelling units and buildings, etc. More preliminary tables will be published during the summer. The final tabulation starts in the autumn 1972.

### 2. Classifications used

In the 1970 census, occupations are classified according to the Nordic standard classification of occupations, which is very similar to the 1958 edition of ISCO. Industry is classified according to the 1968 ISIC. Education is classified according to the Finnish standard classification of education (1971) which in some respects differs from ISQED.

The other classifications and concepts used in the census are mostly in conformity with the United Nation recommendation given for the census. The main exceptions in these tables are mentioned in footnotes.

### 3. The total population figure

According to the preliminary census data, the total population figure was 4 622 299 persons. The final figure will be somewhat below that, because duplicates are to be eliminated. The duplicates are mostly supposed to be students counted at home and at the place of the university, and old people counted at home and in homes for aged.

The population figures for the years 1961-1970 (31 December) were calculated on the basis of the 1960 census, to which population figure births and immigrants were added monthly and from which deaths and emigration between Finland and other countries (especially Sweden) were deducted. The population figures were continuously too high, though. The error on 31 December 1970 compared to the census figure was about 54 000 persons. This difference is ex post to be distributed to each of the years 1961-1970 in the same proportion as the annual net emigration is supposed to have been. A source in this correction work is the immigration statistics of other countries.

The domicile registers, which are updated annually on 1 January, reported a population figure of 4 710 000, which is about 88 000 more than the census figure of the same day. This difference is due to the fact that emigrants are still kept in the domicile register for certain purposes, e.g. to retain their right to vote in elections.

#### 4. Legal basis of the census

The census was performed according to the Census Act of 1938, which stipulates that a regular census of population, dwelling units and real estates be performed every ten years. According to an amendment to the law made in 1971, the individual data collected for the census may be used only for statistical and research purposes, and must not be released for e.g. administrative or commercial purposes.

#### 5. Population censuses 1880-1970

The first general direct population census in Finland was taken in 1950, the second in 1960 and the third on 31 December, 1970. The tables are published in the "Official Statistics of Finland", series VI C:102, VI C:103, respectively. In earlier years a counting of the persons in the local population registers was made; this counting was a so called indirect census. The results of those "censuses" were published in the form of decennial tables (from 1880 to 1940). Besides partial censuses were taken in the biggest towns beginning in 1870. The history of regular population registers goes back to 1751. (See also Statistical Yearbook of Finland, the chapter "Statistics of Finland, published by the State".
