- Open access report August 2015
- 2016: SKS starts open access book publishing with the international Studia Fennica -bookseries.
 - Books will be available electronically in PDF- and EPUBformats.
 - Books will be available in print through print-on-demand.
 - Books will be licensed under CC BY-NC-ND.




