Subject choices of comprehensive school pupils

# Share of comprehensive school pupils studying Russian has increased

According to Statistics Finland, the share of comprehensive school pupils studying Russian on grades 1 to 6 was 0.2 percentage points higher and 0.7 percentage points higher on grades 7 to 9 than in 2013. In 2014, altogether 1.0 per cent of pupils on grades 1 to 6 and 3.1 per cent of pupils on grades 7 to 9 studied Russian.

#### Language choices of comprehensive school pupils in 2014

English was the most commonly studied foreign language on grades 1 to 6 of comprehensive school in the autumn semester of 2014. Sixty-six per cent of the pupils attending grades 1 to 6 studied English either as a compulsory or optional foreign language. The percentages of pupils studying other foreign languages remained at five per cent or below.

Nearly all pupils attending grades 7 to 9 studied both English and Swedish or Finnish either as mother tongue, or as a compulsory, optional or elective foreign language. German was studied by 10 per cent and French by 6 per cent of the pupils attending grades 7 to 9, mainly as an optional or elective foreign language.

A total of 355,139 pupils attended grades 1 to 6. 181,942 of the pupils were boys and 173,197 were girls. A total of 175,686 pupils attended grades 7 to 9. 90,011 of the pupils were boys and 85,675 were girls.

Data on the language choices of students studying comprehensive education elsewhere than at comprehensive schools (1,564) are published in the database table of these statistics.
