It all begins at selection

- List of titles, where language was Swedish
 - Or combined Swedish & Finnish
- Based on National Bibliography
 - Checking of metadata
 - Identifiers important
 - ISSN or National Bibliography Number
- Digitization order based on title name
 - A->Ö
 - (except if there was something complex in the title)






Physical and Digital space


- Material arrives to Mikkeli for digitization
- Works are tracked throughout the process
 - Preparation
 - Scanning
 - Repacking and returning
 - Quality control
- Defining of digitization order <-> equipment & personnel availability






Local logistics

- Repacking after scanning












Two Supag scanners and digitizer at work



Post-processing

Several background servers that run automatically 24/7 for:

- Layout analysis (text paragraphs, illustrations)
- Text recognition
 - Several languages
- Importing to Digi.kansalliskirjasto.fi
 - Database
 - Search index







Long-term preservation & research

- Material delivered to CSC (IT centre for science) for longterm preservation, 500+ years
 - digitalpreservation.fi
- Currently project ongoing called FIN-Clariah, which enables use of materials within CSC high-computing environment
 - Copyright-free material
 - Collaboration with other cultural heritage organizations
 - Both metadata and contents
 - Additional data package and metadata development for data packages in planning











User survey 02/2022, n=202, usage purpose






Over 10.000 page views, years 1940-1949



Top-5 newspapers 1940 & 1944 most read (years 2020-




