2010–2011 Piloting with Ex Libris Primo


New approach:

 - Now: clustered involvement




Usability activities

- 2010: Testing of the service concept
- 2011: User study on end-user interface layouts of the National View

New approach

 From 2012 onwards: Agile user tests, consept analyses, log analyses, focused usability evaluation etc.

- National infrastructure for ALM (Archives, Libraries, Museums) resource retrieval services
- Access to all Finnish ALM resources via single user interface
- One user interface, several end user views
- All foreseeable resources
