TOURS IN FINLAND

Summer, 1924.

The following tours are all arranged to begin and end with Helsingfors. The time allowed is the shortest possible, and extra time must be allowed for excursions and rests.

The Tourist Association cannot be responsible for changes in the time tables and prices which may be made after these routes are printed. Travellers should therefore check the times of arrival and departure in the current time tables. They will in most cases find it a convenience to call at the office of the Tourist Association, Norra Esplanadgatan 21, immediately on arrival in Helsingfors, when all information will be given free of charge. All prices are quoted in Finnish marks.

Itinerary I.

Helsingfors (Helsinki) — Viborg (Viipuri) — Imatra — Savonlinna (Nyslott) — Punkaharju — Kuopio — Kajaani — Vaala — Muhos — Oulu (Uleåborg) — Helsingfors.

 (and class 86: —, 3rd 57: 50, seat ticket in the express train 2nd 10: —, 3rd 5: —, sleeping berth 2nd 35: —, 3rd 20: —).
- 2nd day Dep. Viborg 7.45 a.m., arr. Imatra 10.11 a.m. (Travellers by the night train who wish to see Viborg can leave at 1.44 p.m. arr. Imatra 4.15 p.m., or leave 6.48 p.m. arr. Imatra 9.10 p.m. They can then not leave Imatra until the 3rd day.)

Excursion to Vallinkoski, by motor omnibus several times daily.

Dep. Imatra 4.21 p. m. Arr. Vuoksenniska 4.33 p. m. (2nd class 3: 25, 3rd 2: 25).

Dep. Vuoksenniska immediately by steamboat »Imatra II» or »Savonlinna» across Lake Saima to Savonlinna (Nyslott) (good restaurant and comfortable cabins on the boats). (1st class 70:—, 2nd 40:—).

- 3rd day Arr. Savonlinna (Nyslott) 8.00 a.m. Dep. Savonlinna (Nyslott) 1.15 p.m. by steamboat »Punkaharju», arr. Punkaharju 3.15 p.m. (1st class 15: —, 2nd 10: —).
- 4th day Dep. Punkaharju (train) 8.19 a.m. arr. Savonlinna (Nyslott) 9.35 a.m. (2nd class 9: —, 3rd 6: —).

Dep. Savonlinna (Nyslott) 1.45 p.m. by steamboats »Heinävesi» (via Heinävesi) or »Leppävirta» (via Leppävirta). (1st class 70: —, 2nd 40: —).

5th day Arr. Kuopio 8.00 a. m. (Drive to Puijo Hill).

Dep. Kuopio 12.21 p. m. arr. Kajaani 5.30 p. m. (2nd class 50: 50, 3rd 33: 75).

6th day Dep. Kajaani Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays 7.30 a. m. by steamboat »Salo II», arr. Vaala 12 noon. (1st class 50: —, 2nd 40: —).

Dep. Vaala immediately down the Ule river in the

Tourist Association's river and motor boats.

(75: -, 10% reduction on production of the Tourist

Association's card of membership).

Arr. Muhos about 6.00 p. m. (Dinner is served at Muhos for those who have ordered it from the captain of the

»Salo II» before leaving Vaala).

Dep. Muhos 8.00 p. m. (7.00 p. m. towards the end of the summer).

Arr. Oulu (Uleaborg) (Kurkela wharf) 10.00 p.m. (1st class 14: —, 2nd 12: —, motor omnibus from the wharf to the town 5: —).

The Tourist Association's guest-house Uutela, near Vaala, is a good place to break the journey and rest. It is picturesquely situated on the bank of Niskakoski rapids, has comfortable beds and good cooking, is quiet and homely, and salmon and trout fishing is available.

7th day Dep. Oulu (Uleåborg) 12.05 p. m. or 9.05 p. m. (sleeping car from Seinäjoki) (sleeping car to Seinäjoki)

(2nd class 184: 75, 3rd 123: 25, sleeping berth 2nd 35: —, 3rd 20: —).

8th day Arr. Helsingfors 10.56 a.m. or 7.34 p.m.

Fares for the whole tour: 1st class steamboat, 2nd cl. train Fmk. 725: —.

Fares for the whole tour: 2nd class steamboat, 3rd cl. train Fmk. 499: 75.

Allow about 100:— a day for food and lodging. In some places board and lodging can be obtained for 45:—— 75:— a day for an extended stay.

5th day Arr. Joensuu 8.00 a.m. Dep. Joensuu by train 7.00 p.m. arr. Vuonislahti 9.11 p.m.
(2nd class 25: 25, 3rd 17: —).
Dep. Vuonislahti immediately by steamboat or motorboat for Koli (about 40 minutes). (fare 10: —).
(Travellers who reach Joensuu on a Monday are recommended to proceed from Joensuu to Koli by steamboat *Lieksa* up the Pielis canal. Dep. Joensuu 12.30 p.m., arr. Koli same evening. 1st class 55: —, 2nd 35: —):

Helsingfors (Helsinki)—Viborg (Viipuri)—Imatra—Sortavala—Valamo—Sortavala—Punkaharju—Savonlinna (Nyslott)—Lappeenranta (Villmanstrand)—Helsingfors (Helsinki).

Travellers who wish to combine a tour round Finland with a visit to Sweden, or to the North Cape and the Norwegian fjords, can take Itinerary I or II and then instead of returning from Uleaborg to Helsingfors proceed northwards via Tornio—Haparanda to Sweden, or via Rovaniemi and Finnish Lapland to the north of Norway.
