Vision

DRI links and preserves the rich data held by Irish institutions, providing a central internet **access** point, and **interactive** multimedia tools, for use by the public, **students** and **scholars**.











Goals

- Reduce administrative overhead
- Store as little personal information as possible
- Access control decisions
 - Institution, role (staff, student, alumni)
- Personalization
 - Saved searches, bookmarks
- For users:
 - One less password
 - Simplifies registration












Edugate

- Federated access management system
 - -SAML federation
 - IdP authenticates users
 - SP authorizes users based on IdP information
- Service provided by HEAnet
 - Ireland's research and education network
- Allow users to access Edugate enabled services using credentials issued by their institution










Implementation

- Application host
 - Apache
 - Shibboleth SP (shibd + mod_shib)
 - Rails application
- Local test IdP
 - Useful for development
 - User accounts in LDAP














Implementation

- Ruby on Rails
- Devise
 - Authentication solution
- Omniauth
 - Multi-provider authentication
 - Implemented as strategies, e.g.
 - Facebook
 - Twitter
- Omniauth Shibboleth
 - SAML strategy








